Rules:

- Inter college teams are allowed.

- The candidates will be required to present working principal along with demonstration of model or presentation and then it will be followed by questions-answers session.

- The participant can be of any department.
- Certificates will be given to all the participants.
- Each member of the team must contain the Identity card of his/her respected institute.
